Pastors Pen . . . August 14, 2017

Hate raised its clenched fist last week in Charlottesville, Virginia as several hundred persons from various white supremacy groups lit torches and marched into this university city. Such a display met predictable opposition from courageous protestors who refused to remain silent as those who once hid behind white sheets felt emboldened to shout racial hatred in public. One protestor was killed and several injured when a twenty-year-old white supremacist accelerated his car into a group of pedestrians.

How should the Christian respond to such hatred? When enmity between law enforcement and African Americans arose elsewhere in our country this past year, committed community leaders in Beaumont joined forces with local law enforcement and proclaimed together, "Not in my city!" If white supremacists choose to come to Beaumont, we will see broad swaths of our city unite and loudly proclaim, "Not in my city!"

Followers of Christ proclaim love and unity as we model the life Jesus lived. His message of God's love for all resulted in his execution by those who would exacerbate conflict among people groups to further their own power and privilege. When hate raises its clenched fist today, followers of Christ unite our voices and our lives and shout from the rooftops, "Not in my city! Not in my state! Not in my country! Not now! Not ever again!"
