Games for Children

We welcomed over 50 students to **Vacation Bible School** last week. About 40 volunteers brought to life the theme, "Water You Doing?" The curriculum, one of the most effective we have used, helped the children know more about the need for clean water in Malawi (a landlocked country in southeastern Africa) and how that need affects daily life. Teachers enabled the children to see that other people meet some of our needs and that God expects us to help meet some of the needs of other people – like bringing clean water to the rural villages of Malawi.

The children used empty water bottles to collect change last week and will give the money to help bring clean water to Malawi. Brian, the youth, and other volunteers recently completed another garage sale with proceeds totaling \$4,200 (WOW)! Half of those funds will be given to *Watering Malawi*, a project we have supported in this way for over a decade, with half going to another mission project. Thank you for being the kind of congregation that teaches children about helping others! We lift our prayers to the needy throughout God's world.

We pray for peace in our country following the wounding on June 14 of **Representative Steve Scalise** and four others during a shooting in Arlington, Virginia that targeted Republican lawmakers practicing for an annual charity baseball game. The shooter was killed by authorities. We pray for the recovery of the victims as we lift grateful hearts for the unity throughout our country condemning this act of violence and praying for the recovery of the victims. Leaders are calling for a new spirit of cooperation that dials down inflammatory rhetoric that has become a facet of our public discourse. Join me in praying for our leaders and for one another as we join this effort.
